- Whether you are light or dark complexioned, you need to protect your skin.
- Please bring insect repellent, particularly for the evening rehearsals.
- Please consider bringing your own small coolers. Make sure you keep yourself hydrated and avoid caffeinated beverages and beverages with sugar.
- Please make sure you purchase a heavy-duty music stand from **Gadsden Music on Sunday morning, August 12**, when you register. This pertains to the front ensemble as well.
- Please make sure you have a ring binder notebook with a sufficient number of medium to heavy duty plastic sheet protectors.
- If you play snare—please make sure you bring a stand.
- Please wear comfortable and supportive footwear. **Sandals, flip-flops**, and anything similar is not allowed at any rehearsal. This pertains to the percussion staff as well.
